Since the October 24th Board Meeting, the high visibility media issues included: the announcement of the October enrollment numbers; President Obama's announcement regarding the delay of health plans being cancelled; the Attorney General shutting down phony Covered California websites; maintenance and upgrades being made to the CoveredCA.com enrollment website; the unveiling of the Asian-language ads and billboards to consumers; Alameda Alliance being removed from Covered California; the We Connect health care event; the weekly release of numbers and data regarding the website and applications; and general coverage and opinions on Covered California and the Affordable Care Act.
