### COVERED CALIFORNIA BOARD CLIPS November 2, 2016 – January 24, 2017

Since the November 9 board meeting, high-visibility media issues include: Covered California official stating Affordable Care Act repeal will not happen soon, an independent study by The Commonwealth Fund showed Covered California consumers paying much less than expected for health care, an editorial about Gov. Jerry Brown and Insurance Commissioner Dave Jones letters to House Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy about the possible repeal of the Affordable Care Act.

Since the November 9 board meeting, the term "Covered California" was mentioned 22,500 and the phrase "California Health Benefit Exchange" was mentioned 431 times. The following clips represent a cross-section of media and coverage.
