Since the January 26 board meeting, high-visibility media issues include: Covered California receiving high praise from a Brookings Institution analysis as a top model of how health care exchanges can be run, California reducing its uninsured rate to a record low, a surge in town hall activism giving Republicans pause as to how to "repeal and replace" the legislation and stories saying the Affordable Care Act is now more popular than ever.
