COVERED CALIFORNIA BOARD CLIPS January 23, 2014 – February 18, 2014

Since the January 23rd Board Meeting, the high visibility media issues included: the suspension of small-business online enrollment; Covered California Enrollment statistics through the week of February 8th; upgrades and increases in staffing to improve customer service; partnerships with Los Angeles libraries to provide information to where consumers can enroll in person; removal of the online provider directory; the additions of the Quality Rating System when choosing a health plan; staff additions to the Covered California Board; the issuing of Covered California's federal grant, and general coverage and opinions on Covered California and the Affordable Care Act.
