Since the Aug. 20 board meeting, high-visibility media issues included: a U.S. Census Report confirming California’s success reducing its uninsured rate; a Field Poll finding more California residents are satisfied with their health insurance and increasingly support the Affordable Care Act; and general coverage and opinions on Covered California and the Affordable Care Act.
