Re: Health4All Covered California Expansion and "Mirror" Marketplace Development

Dear Covered California Board:

We, the 95 undersigned organizations, as members of the Health4All coalition are writing to urge the Covered California Board to work with advocates and the Legislature to prioritize and establish a "mirror" marketplace that will open up Covered California to all Californians, regardless of immigration status.

The Covered California "mirror" marketplace would offer health plans to undocumented individuals who are excluded by federal law from shopping for coverage on Covered California. Colorado has implemented a mirrored exchange, Colorado Connect, providing proof of concept and allowing 11,000 of their undocumented residents to get coverage.

The UC Berkeley Labor Center estimates that of the 2.57 million uninsured Californians, about 520,000 who are undocumented and earn too much to qualify for Medi-Cal would otherwise be eligible to purchase plans on Covered California if not for their immigration status. Another 110,000 undocumented Californians are insured in the private market, but would be eligible to enroll through Covered California if this barrier were removed<sup>1</sup>.

We appreciate the work that California has done so far to expand Medi-Cal coverage to all-income eligible adults, but more remains to be done to move the state towards universal coverage for all. We look forward to continuing to work with Covered California on this critical issue.
